Thanks to everyone who participated in our 2026 5-Buckle Overshoe matches. I thought we had a pretty good weekend - a little wind and cool temps on Saturday (kind of usual stuff for early May up here in NoDak) and a bit warmer with challenging up and down winds on Sunday. The e-Targets ran good – but there seemed to be some connection issues. Interesting, some folks that had older iPad's had better luck connecting to the Access Point – we'll see how this works out over the outdoor High Power Season. Always nice to have good attendance at our events. We had 47 entries over the 3 events this weekend compared to 50 entries at the 5-Buckle last year. Be sure to look at the calendar on the [ndssa.org](http://ndssa.org) website and plan your summer high power schedule

The weekend opened with the M1 Garand (or Vintage) Match Saturday morning. Jess Bush fired a 266-5x for the Match Winner (using the period correct rifle) and a CMP Bronze pin. Good shooting Jess – yes, the wind was a little tough on the offhand scores. Jeremy Thomas was the high score in the event firing the Modern Military Rifle with a 277-4x – excellent score in the windy conditions. Next up was the was the EIC or “Leg” match. The wind kind of beat up everyone as no one was able to fire the minimum qualification score (455/500) for this event. Coby Dalgliesh fired a 432-5x for the match win.

The Long Range event was held on Sunday - 4 – 20 shot strings from 1000 yards (25 shots for Match No. 4 for the F-Class guys). Lighter winds on Sunday – but they kept switching from the southwest to the northwest with lots of variable speed thrown in. Several competitors went right off the target. As always – I HIGHLY recommend taking a spotting scope to the line to help read wind (and also use the spotting scope to observe the guy shooting while you score for them). Most guys don't do that these days - you're never going to learn to read wind conditions if you don't use a spotting scope (all the time). The Sling Shooter match winner was Neil Jensen with a 752-15x. The F-Open category match winner was Troy Goltz with an 822-29x (850 possible). The F-Target Rifle match winner was Dave Rohrich with a 758-21x (again 850 possible). We ran 2 relays on 12 Shot Marker e-targets. The match took us just a little over 4 hours to fire. Not too bad shooting 4 strings of fire. As always – the use of e-Targets shortens the day a couple hours.

The next event on the 2026 NoDak High Power Season Schedule will be the May Turtle Mountain Matches on Saturday, May 16. Coby will have a 60 Shot 600-yard match (3 x 20). Last year we followed this with a 2-man Team match (Sling, F-Open and F/TR) – maybe we'll do this again. Then on Sunday he'll have a 30 shot CMP Garand match followed by a 50-shot CMP EIC (“Leg”) Match. If you're planning to attend this event - inform Coby Dalgliesh soon as you can. Email Coby at [cobykdalgliesh@gmail.com](mailto:cobykdalgliesh@gmail.com). This is a “protected range” surrounded by forest in the Turtle Mountains (not your usual NoDak prairie) – great place to shoot.

**The next High Power event at our range will be the 2026 NRA F-Class Full Bore National Championships May 28, 29 and 30, 2026. We will also have a V-Series match on Sunday, May 31. There may be a couple spots still open for this match – so if you are interested – sign up NOW! All registrations are taken through Practiscore. The course of fire is 45 shots for record each day (800, 900 and 1000 yards). There will also be a team match. There is quite a pile of donations from major manufacturers for all type of stuff including actions, barrels, a Shot Marker, and many discount and gift certificates for the equipment used in the F-Class game. If you can (and if there is still room) – I highly encourage you to attend this event. It's not often when we have a National Championship event held locally.
