Dakota Territory Championship 2016 Summary:

Landis Machine again made classic steel trophies and etched some bottles of medicinal grade, Tennessee cold filtered via oak charred barrels ethyl so that the top three places were duly rewarded and like 2015, Landis Machine also crafted steel trophies for each of the individual state champions in the four states. See notes at the end of the bulletin on the awards that are hand crafted for the Dakota Territory Silhouette Championships as well as the genesis for the concept in 2014.

In 2016, the four states that comprised the original Dakota Territory held their respective state silhouette championships on weekends through the summer. Those four State Silhouette Championships provided an opportunity to crown an overall Dakota Territory Silhouette Champion based on the cumulative scores of however many of those four State Championships a participant was able to attend. There are tables that provide the specifics but these tables only include participants who attended two or more state championships. High points of this third year of the Dakota Territory Championship include 20 participants being able to attend two or more of the four State Silhouette Championships and pretty decent weather at all the matches.

The first match was in Lander for the **WY Championship** over the weekend of June 11 and 12. Roger Sebesta, Tony and crew put on a fine match with accommodating weather as well for both shooting and camping. David Bonner was the overall champion with a score 241 out 320 critters, with Ryan Habeck second with 213 and Clint Habeck third at 207. David won three of the four rifle matches with Clint winning High Power Hunting Rifle. Match Director Sebesta, in years past had dubbed Ryan "the kid" and the moniker seemed appropriate given he is too young to vote but seemed to shoot offhand beyond his years and placed in most every class he fired in even if he didn't overall in any gun.

The second match was the **ND** Championship held August 6 & 7 with pleasant conditions. Ryan "the Kid" Habeck was the overall winner with 113 critters out of 160 while Clint Habeck and Scott Larson were tied for second with 91. The Kid was also the match winner in each gun, the first time in recent memory anyone could recall that happening at the ND match. He had a few close individual matches that he still won but his overall total score was nearly 15% better than the next closest total score, which also turned out to be the biggest winning margin of all the four state championship matches in 2016. It seems we need to import more shooting talent or distractions to make the Kid sweat a little, 'cause the old timers aren't cutting it.

For those that might be thinking about the ND championship matches, the range has a terrific grill and some really nice camping spots with a number of buildings that one can sleep in so no need to bring a tent or trailer unless you want to. There are plenty of other shooters camping as well so food and conversation after the matches is readily available. The SD contingent tends to get there Friday evening for practice and barbequing so make plans accordingly.

The third match was the **SD Championship** held August 27 & 28 in SD at the Timber Lake and Trail City ranges. Some nice improvements have occurred at these ranges in recent years and they are of a size that easily accommodated the participants plus there is nice camping at the high power range. A bit of wind occurred during the high power match but with the recent range improvements it was nothing like unsubstantiated rumors you may have heard of in the past. The match winner was Scott Larson with 163 of 240 critters with Clint Habeck second at 157 and Kent Geffre third at 147. The Kid couldn't attend the SD match which likely materially shifted the standings for both that match and the overall standings of the 2016 Dakota Territory Championship. The final leg of Dakota Territory run was the **MT Championship** at the Deep Creek range over the Labor Day weekend on September 3-4. There were refreshing temperatures at Missoula and as usual Mike and Monica ran a top notch event. Eric Boos was first overall with 204 of 240 critters, with Paul Davis second at 189 and the Kid was third at 182.

The overall Dakota Territory Championship match winner was Clint Habeck with a score of 622 on the right side of the picture and next to him is second place winner Scott Larson at 607. Kent Geffre, on the left keeping his temples warm and protected from loud noises, was third with a score of 559.

Each of those place winners received an embellished bottle of medicinal grade Tennessee ethyl in the half gallon size. A new tradition ensued whereby the third place trophy of medicinal grade ethyl was opened for anyone feeling a bit under the weather – after the match was over of course. There were a few folks needing a pull . . . and some that didn't but couldn't resist.



Dakota Territory Championship Concept Inception June 2014

Silhouette Enthusiasts

Bear with us while we tell a story and present an idea. Dakota Territory was formally designated in 1861 and comprised both Dakotas and most of Montana and Wyoming (see map). Dakota Territory was carved out of portions of Minnesota and Nebraska Territories. Typical of those times, the shape of the Territories changed regularly and Dakota was no different. By 1868, MT and WY had been cleaved off from



Dakota Territory and by statehood in 1889; Dakota was further split north and south leaving the former Dakota Territory of 1861 to form the core of four new States.

A few of us from the Dakotas have attended the Montana Ironmen Silhouette Matches in early June the last couple years. It has been much fun visiting a quality range with great folks/weather conditions and got us to thinking about traveling to other nearby matches. Turns out in 2014, the stars have aligned such that the former Dakota Territory states of Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wyoming are having their respective State Silhouette Championships on different weekends but all within a 30 day period from mid-August to early September 2014.

Ironman Epiphany

On our ride back to South Dakota a few weeks ago from the 2014 MT Ironman, it struck us that, in addition to middle aged men having a bladder the size of a thimble, the four State Silhouette Championships provide an opportunity to crown an overall Dakota Territory/Quad State Silhouette Champion. It would be based on the cumulative scores of however many of those four silhouette State Championships a participant was able to attend. It might be calm at some matches or perhaps an occasionally wisp of breeze in the Dakotas but overall the more matches one could attend the better your chances and it could generate some additional mixing of participants between State Championships. Landis Machine has agreed to make appropriate trophies that would be presented for the Dakota Territory Match Winners at the end of the final State Championship Match in Montana.

So the question is – would anybody care if some of the Dakota shooters made trophies and presented such items at the end of the four State Championship run so that there is an overall winner comprised of the highest cumulative scores from the four state silhouette championships that make up the former Dakota Territory? Sincerely, Scott Larson, Kelly Landis, Kent Geffre and Kirk Caldwell.

A note about the Dakota Territory Silhouette Awards

Landis Machine of Trail City makes the awards for the Dakota Territory match. These are classic steel trophies (what other materials could there be for a silhouette championship) as well as etched bottles of medicinal grade, Tennessee cold filtered via oak charred barrels ethyl in the half gallon size - because a pint just wouldn't cut it for such a marvelous chunk of country. The steel trophies and elixir are substantial in both size and heft and unique from most anything you'll come across. In 2014, Landis Machine provided these awards for the three highest combined overall scores of the Dakota Territory Championship.



In 2015, Landis Machine provided an award for each of the individual state champions (see pic of the MT high overall award winner Paul Davis below) as well as three highest combined overall scores across all four championships. Incidentally, the brains and brawn of Landis Machine is in the red *coca cola* shirt on the left camouflaging his trademark *carhartt* bib overalls while the second pic shows him handing a





third place award to Ryan "the kid" Habeck.
