Thanks to everyone who participated in our 2021 5-Buckle Overshoe matches. I looked back at my match report last year – we were right in the middle of the COVID crap....and we're still not out of it. Let's hope this stuff will get behind us someday and we can get back to normal – like buying primers at the store.

Anyhow, we had a very good turnout for our first event of the 2021 High Power Season considering the current shortage (or whatever it is) of reloading supplies. We had 42 entries this year compared to 31 last year (but we didn't run a Garand match last year). The big year was 2018 when we had 74 entries. Let's see if we can get those guys out again to shoot some matches. The season is here – so get out there and shoot.

We kicked off the 2021 High Power Season with a return to our Vintage match starting at about 9am Saturday morning. Travis Carico put up a nice 291-5x in the windy conditions for the high score in the Vintage match. Nice shooting Travis – but he was shooting in the Modern Military class. So, the Match Winner firing the M1 Garand was Jim Ladwig with a 262-2x. Good shooting Jim.

On to the Long Range match. Well, just about every year...we seem to have this wind problem. And if windy conditions aren't bad enough – some direction changes have to be thrown in. Once again, we had 15 – 20mph (or so) wind and some direction changes - Northwest to just about straight out of West. Most guys had a real nice waterline – problem was - it was from one side of the target all the way to the other side. We also seem to run into some e-Targets issues with bad, poor or lost signal. Anyhow – we all made it through the Long Range match.

Aaron Gulizzua was the sling match winner with a 567-6x. His score last year was a 558 – so maybe things weren't as bad as last year. Brian Suhr was the F-Open winner with a 566-9x. Last year Garald Gillies was the top F-Open shooter with a 537-6x (hey - apparently those winds were challenging last year). Dave Rohrich was the F/TR winner with a 524-4x. Last year Chris Longley from MN was the high F/TR shooter with a 510-6x. So perhaps things weren't as bad this year as last – funny how that goes.

Sunday turned out to be one of the nicest days for an X-Course match since we opened this place in the summer of 2000. It was overcast and hardly any wind. The wind picked up just a bit for the last relay at 600 yards - but you couldn't complain about Sunday's weather. Arron Guliuzza fired a very nice 781-29x for the match win. Travis Carico fired a 741-13x to win the Expert/Marksman class. I ran the line and only had to call for 2 target marks for the day. When the wind is down – things always go smoother.

The next High Power event at our range will be the North Dakota Long Range State Championship the weekend of June 12 and 13. The State event weekend includes the State Championship match on Saturday (June 12) and then a "Registered" Palma match (not part of the Long Range State Championship) on Sunday (June 13). Events are for sling, F/Open and F/TR. As always - Non-residents can compete in our State Championship events. We encourage and welcome your participation. Non-residents can be the match winner however; the high overall resident is recognized as the North Dakota State Champion.

The 2021 Summer High Power season is here. Plan your summer shooting sports schedule. You can check the full calendar for all the shooting events for our state at the NDSSA website (ndssa.org). Be sure to contact match directors so they know you're coming. In addition, there are events in Montana, Minnesota and South Dakota. Be sure to check their State Association websites for match information and match director contacts.
