It takes a LOT of help to put on an event like this – thanks to all that helped me with the match.

Congratulations to our Air Rifle Sectional winners – Gold - Mari Butler 576, Silver - Emily Hagg 571 (by tie breaker) and Bronze – Lana Fairbanks 571. Joe Martin was the top Master with a 570. Megan Tichy won the Expert class with a 561. Madison Marchus fired a 546 to win the Sharpshooter Class, and Rylie Shull fired 569 for the Marksman Class win. The Team winners – Buffalo Sharpshooters Gold – Emily Hagg, Mari Butler and Megan Tichy fired a 1708/1800.

Congratulations to the Smallbore Sectional winners – Gold – Joe Martin 1124, Silver medal and top Sharpshooter was Bennett Christianson with an 1114, and Bronze medalist was Lana Fairbanks with a 1087. The top Marksman was Tyler Linneman with a 1085. The Forks Rifle Club of Joe, Rebecca Martin, Tyler Linneman, and Karleigh Gause were the team winners with a 4264.

A lot of great scores were fired. Mari Butler equaled the State record for a 10 Shot string/air rifle with a perfect 100 – this has now been accomplished 4 times in open competitions in North Dakota. Bennett Christianson fired a new state record for iron sights, kneeling with a 377/400. This previous record was a 376/400 fired by Soren Butler on January 14, 2012.

We have 3 more events at our range this year including a 50 yard NRA Open Regional Smallbore Rifle Championship on February 22 and 23. This will be a 1 day event – 120 shots for record, any sight match. Please put this on your schedule – this should be fun. The Junior 4-Position Smallbore Rifle State Championship and Sectional matches will be the weekend of March 8 and 9, 2014. Finally, we will have our Junior Club championship on

Saturday, March 22, 2014. This will be a conventional 4-Position 40-shot event. Awards will be provided to the top shooter, and class winners from the Bismarck/Mandan R&P Association. Juniors from other clubs are invited. Winners from other clubs will be recognized with certificates.

The North Dakota Shooting Sports Association annual convention is in Bismarck the weekend of February 1 and 2, 2013. We will recognize 2013 state champions and 2013 state records (including Junior competitors) at the Saturday night banquet. North Dakota Attorney General, Wayne Stenehjem will be our guest speaker. The NDSSA annual membership meeting will be Saturday afternoon. There will also be Light Rifle match at the Johnson Family Marksmanship Center (our indoor range in Bismarck) on Sunday.
